RESOLUTION NO. 398-20**

**A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE TOWN  
HALL POCKET PARK AS A TOWN PARK**

**WHEREAS**, the Town is in the process of updating its parks plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the draft parks plan refers to a parcel of Town property as the “Town Hall Pocket Park” located at the end of the Strong Park footbridge next to Town Hall at 375 2<sup>nd</sup> Street between said Town Hall and Beal Street; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of efficient park planning to formally recognize the “Town Hall Pocket Park” as part of the Town’s system of parks.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CATHLAMET, WASHINGTON**, as follows:

Section 1. The parcel of property commonly referred to as the “Town Hall Pocket Park” is hereby recognized as a Town park for purposes of Chapter 12.30 of the Cathlamet Municipal Code.

Section 2. This Resolution is effective immediately upon its adoption.
